Daniel Shaw, Massachusetts, A102040

- Corporal, Pension S*W19028
- Residence: Ashfield Hampshire Co MA
- Born: 29 Sep 1742 Bridgewater Plymouth Co MA
- Died: 20 Sep 1830 Sparta Livingston Co NY

On 18 Oct 1770 Daniel married Olive Lillie (d 2 May 1837) in Ashfield MA. As of Fall 2021, NSDAR recognizes daughters from their children: Joseph, Samuel and John.

Additional children were Daniel, Mehitable, Sarah, Zachariah, Oliver, and Eunice.

- Joseph (b p31 Dec 1786 Ashfield Springfield MA d p1845 Putnam Co IN) married in 1810 to Mary Hume (b c1784 d p1849 IN).
- Samuel (b c1788 NY d 28 Feb 1875 San Pierre IN) in 1811 married Sarah Livings (b 13 Jun 1793 d 11 Sep 1877).
- John (b 17 Sep 1792 Saratoga NY, d 8 Sep 1883) married on 3 Jan 1815 to Clarissa Stearns (b 18 Oct 1792 VT, d 21 Mar 1863).

Shaw enlisted in Feb 1777 at Ashfield MA and was in battles of Saratoga against General Burgoyne, Monmouth Court House, and the siege of Ft Staunwix (Stanwix) in New York. He served in Capt Samuel Bartlett's Company and Col James Wesson's Regt.
