- Write a story about Apollo 11 as if the writer's father was one of the astronauts, Neil Armstrong, Michael Collins or Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin.
- Create a banner depicting the timeline of the United States starting with Alan Shephard's May 5, 1961 launch into orbit aboard the Freedom 7 capsule atop of the Redstone Mercury 3 rocket to Neil Armstrong's declaration as he stepped onto the moon, "That's one small step for man, one giant step for mankind" on July 21, 1969.
