



Service to America Committee

To honor the 19th amendment of the U. S. A. Constitution, President General Ann Turner Dillon set a goal of 19 million volunteer hours to be reported via the NSDAR Online Tally during her administration.

Each Iowa daughter should report five (5) hours per month during 2018 as Iowa's proportional participation toward this goal.

Chapter Chairs of the Service to America Committee are encouraged:

1. To create a mechanism for contacting members – whether they attend meetings, are officers, are committee chairs or **NOT** (e.g. telephone direct, telephone tree, email, text)
2. To provide members access guidelines defining eligible volunteer hours and instructions to log hours on the NSDAR Online Tally
3. To monitor via eMembership the status of Online Tally hours reported by chapter members in comparison to the chapter's 2018 goal. (Remember, all volunteer hours are to be reported via Online Tally; no hours are reported via the annual Chapter Master Report, Service to America Committee page.)
4. To utilize Iowa Society DAR website, Service to America Committee section for guidance, support, program resources and handouts. This material is NOT subject to password protection; please use and share freely.

The July/August, 2018, Volume 18, No. 4, *Daughters of the American Revolution Newsletter*, page 299, provides instructions for a chapter to publish activities in the Newsletter's, *With the Chapters* section. This is an excellent medium for sharing nationally.

Continue to report member's service activity during the regular meeting. Record this report in the chapter minutes. This will be included in the year end Chapter Master Report.
