



Standards for Patriot Story Submissions to ISDAR America 250!

Patriot Stories Website

- Your Patriot Story (Story) should feature your Patriot's life during the period of the American Revolution (19 April 1775 – 26 November 1783).
- The Patriot's service record (military, civil, patriotic) must meet current NSDAR standards. Your Chapter Registrar is to verify the service record per NSDAR guidance prior to submission. See below.
- Label the Microsoft Word document: Patriot's Name and Ancestor Number e.g., Moses Yell A203663
- Provide the following proven information: patriot name, ancestor number, type and state of service, pension number (if available), residence, born date and location, buried date and location, wife's name, wife's born and burial date, locations and names of proven children with their known born, marriage dates and locations.
- Provide known information regarding the Patriot's service i.e., where, when and with whom.
- Identify the Story Source(s) as submitted on the DAR application. Identify folk lore sources as such.
- Submission of your Story indicates your permission to post the Story on the ISDAR Public Website.
- Submit your Story to your Chapter Registrar who will verify that the Patriot's service meets current NSDAR standards.
- Neither your name, your national number nor your Registrar's name will be listed on the website.
